Evans is the daughter of former Australian player Jenny Reisener who competed for Australia at the 1990 World Championships in Brazil. Reisener is a member of the Cairns Basketball Hall of Fame and it looks like daughter Teyla is set to follow in her footsteps.

In 2010 Teyla gained selection in the Australian under-17 squad. She has played most of her early career in the QBL with the Cairns Dolphins and is currently playing with the Dandenong Rangers in the WNBL.

"Teyla is a diamond in the rough. We are very lucky to get a young talented player such as Teyla to play a key part in our team. Standing at 182 cm Teyla is able to guard and play 3 positions on the court, which is a tremendous asset for us and will make her a very versatile player in the team." Lady Bandits Coach Michael Brookens said today.

Brookens says Teyla will play an important part in the 2015 line-up as she looks to take on more responsibility and greater role with the Lady Bandits.
